Christine Clarke

Currently Christine Clarke teaches music at Launceston Church Grammar School. Her teaching experience of over 25 years covers both Primary, Senior and Tertiary levels. Alongside her classroom practice Christine has a depth of expertise in directing instrumental ensembles and vocal groups.

Christine studied flute at the University of Tasmania – Conservatorium of Music (Hobart) under Professor David McCubbin. She gained her Bachelor of Music (Hons) and it was during this time that Christine successfully auditioned for the Australian Youth Orchestra and the International Youth Orchestra.

After completing a Diploma of Education Christine moved to Launceston. It was in Launceston that Christine played for a number of years with the University Wind Orchestra and taught several flute undergraduates at the Launceston Campus of the University.

Christine loves musical theatre and, as well as directing numerous school musicals, she has been involved in directing community theatre groups and choirs. She enjoys teaching and playing the flute and is an active examiner for the Australian Music Examinations Board.

Rob Smithies A.Mus.A Victoria

Born in Burnie, Rob started his musical career in the Burnie Citizens Band at age 9 under the baton of Bandmaster Trevor Reid.

After winning several state and national titles on cornet and soprano cornet Rob switched to trumpet for study at the Tasmanian Conservatorium of Music.

An Australian Youth Orchestra season in 1974 led to a successful audition for the Elizabethan Melbourne Orchestra (now Orchestra Victoria). Rob retired from OV at the end of 2013 after 39 years, mostly as Principal Trumpet.

Rob also played with the Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra, Australian Chamber Orchestra, Adelaide Symphony Orchestra, Australian Pops Orchestra and Stadtorchester St. Gallen (Switzerland). As well as Opera, Ballet and Concert commitments Rob enjoyed an extensive solo career specialising in baroque repertoire on D and Piccolo trumpets.

Rob taught trumpet at The Victorian College of the Arts (where he was acting head of brass in the early 1990s) Melbourne University faculty of Music, Melba Conservatorium and Kantonsschule Trogen (Switzerland).

As a frequent competitor in TBL events from 1966 to 1974 Rob is looking forward to returning as an adjudicator in 2018

Ian Cooper

Ian Cooper completed his music degree in Tasmania at the Conservatorium of Music in the 1980's and played for several years freelancing with the Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra.

From 1988 till 2011 he lived in Melbourne where he completed two more music/education diplomas and played with most of the professional and amateur music groups including the Melbourne Symphony Orchestra and many Big Bands (example, Dizzies Jazz Club Band).

A teacher in Victoria for 23 years he played for the Kew Band (Australasia's Top A grade Brass Band at that time) and was involved in many CD recordings including the film recording Young Einstein – a work of Yahoo Serious's and Kew Band's many band recordings.

He has been Australia's soprano cornet champion and Victorian Trumpet champion.

From 2012 - 2016 he has been travelling the world as a trumpet player on Princess Cruise ships playing with some of the world's best musicians.

He owns a large brass music library and has taught several local players. He is currently seeking to get more involved with music on the coast. A new member of the T.B.L's music advisory board, he is involved with the EMUS music program on the coast as well as the brass program at Leighlands Christian School (Burnie Campus).

Ian plays with Burnie's Brass and Concert Bands, the Cradle Coast Orchestra and directs Wynyard's Stage Band.

Ian's contacts with brass bands has led to competing in nearly 30 nationals, travelling to New Zealand for their championships and a band trip to Thailand.
