Joe Stanbrough served for over 70 years in Brass Banding in both Victoria and Tasmania. was Drum Major of the famous Collingwood Band during the time of Massa Johnston. He was both a Life Member and holder of the Badge of Honour with the T.B.L. serving over 12 years as the League Secretary and 29 years as Treasurer. During his banding acreer, he was a Drill Adjudicator and a member of the League's Drill Advisory Board for some 36 years. His services to the Tasmanian Bands League and to banding in Tasmania and Australia have been greatly appreciated by so many people. His family and the League have perpetuated a trophy in his honour.


