- 2. Bandpersons must appear in band uniform.
- 3. Competitors will be permitted to use their own accompanist in any section provided that the chosen accompanist is available when the competitor is due to perform, otherwise the competitor must use the official accompanist.
- 4. Music for Champion of Champions and Non-Championship Classes will be Own Choice.
- 5. All own choice music must be handed to the appropriate official half $(\frac{1}{2})$ an hour before section commences. All bars must be numbered.
- 6. Competitors must report to the contest co-ordinator at least 20 minutes before commencement of their respective class.
- 7. Time limits will be adhered to:-

Classes 23 - 28 4 minutes Classes 29 - 37 6 minutes

- 8. Juvenile and Junior age limits apply at the date of the Championship, 2nd June 1991.
- 9. Winners in Classes 1 10 and Classes 12 21, must compete in Classes 11 and 22 respectively or forfeit the win in their class.
- 10. NO COMPETITOR MAY USE THE SAME ITEM MORE THAN ONCE DURING THE COMPETITION.

Chief Adjudicator: Mr. Don Cushion
Don has been appointed Chief Adjudicator, where his vast
experience and knowledge should prove most beneficial,
particularly to the Junior Soloists. He commenced his musical
career with the Brunswick City Band at the age of 8 years,
became Principal Cornetist at 16 years and Deputy Bandmaster
at 18 years.

Don has been associated with Dance bands, television, radio and recordings over many years, and in 1950 was appointed Principal Trumpet with the Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra-a position he retained till 1974. He has adjudicated at many State Championships - Band, Solo and Party, as well as adjudicating in Victoria, N.S.W. and Western Australia. He has also been on the Adjudicating Panel of five National Championships. He is sure to prove a valuable asset to our 1991 Championships.

Adjudicator: Mr. Bruce Lamont, B.A.Grad.Dip.Perf., Dip.Sch.Mus., L.Mus.A.

This is the first opportunity Bruce has had to be associated with the T.B.L. Solo and Party Championships, and his adjudication will be eagerly awaited.

He began the cornet at the age of 8 years with the Hyde St. School Band in Footscray, Victoria. During the following six years he became Junior Champion of Victoria and South Australia and Australian Junior Champion in 1968.

During full-time study at the Tasmanian Conservatorium of Music from 1971 - 74, he became Principal Trumpet for the Australian Youth Orchestra, and in 1974 was appointed to his present position as Principal Trumpet of the Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra. Besides his performing committments, Bruce is a tutor in trumpet at the Tasmanian Conservatorium of Music and a brass examiner for the A.M.F.B.


