- 6. Competitors must report to the Contest Co-ordinator at least 20 minutes before commencement of their respective class.
- 7. Time limits will be adhered to: All Solos 4 minutes Duets & Ensemble 6 minutes
- 8. Juvenile and Junior age limits apply at the date of the Championship, 31st May, 1992.
- 9. Winners in Classes 1 20 must compete in Classes 42 and 43 respectively or forfeit the win in their class.
- 10. No competitor may use the same item more than once during the competition excepting in Champion of Champions.
