5. All own choice must be handed to the appropriate official half an hour before section commences. All bars must be numbered.
6. Competitors must report to the Contest Co-ordinator at least 20 minutes before commencement of their respective class.
7. Time limits will be adhered to: - All Solos 4 minutes
Duets & Ensemble 6 minutes
8. Juvenile and Junior age limits apply at the date of the Championship, 31st May, 1992.
9. Winners in Classes 1 - 20 must compete in Classes 42 and 43 respectively or forfeit the win in their class.
10. No competitor may use the same item more than once during the competition excepting in Champion of Champions.
