

#### **DIAGRAM B - QUICK STEP MARCH**



### BANDS MUST PLAY THROUGHOUT DIAGRAM. MUSIC IS JUDGED

Bands will fall-in marching formation at AA and move off in Quick Time and march to DD. On arriving at DD, Band will left turn and march to EE. At EE, Band will right turn between the flags. At FF, Band will Counter March front to rear and flank to flank and march to GG. At GG, Band will left wheel between flags and march to HH. At HH, Band will halt and continue to play to the end of strain. All evolutions must be performed within diagram. Band means front rank.

\*Drill judge shall commence at command "Band Ready" and shall cease when the Drum Major has given the command "Stand at Ease" at Halt.


