### X Norm Harris

Norm Harris grew up locally in Launceston and joined the Army as an Apprentice Trumpet Player. In 1969 he travelled to America playing trumpet, and then later to Western Samoa for a year as the Director of Music at the College. He toured the world with the Daly Wilson Big Band.

In 1981 he went to Las Vegas, playing lead trumpet at the Flamingo Hilton Hotel for a year. He has held many other teaching positions, including the Sydney Conservatorium of Music, Melbourne University (6 years), and Professor of Trumpet at the Defence Force of Music in Victoria (5 years).

Today Norm is semi retired, and works as a freelance trumpet player and teaches trumpet. He also adjudicates competitions around Victoria and runs clinics with community and school bands.
