CONDITIONS OF CONTEST

- All rules of the National Band Council and Tasmanian Bands League will be strictly enforced.
- 2. Bandspersons must appear in band uniform.
- 3. Competitors will be permitted to use their own accompanist in any section provided that the chosen accompanist is available when the competitor is due to perform. Otherwise, the competitor must use an official accompanist.
- 4. All Own Choice music must be handed to the appropriate official at least 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the section. Please note that two (2) adjudicators' copies will be required for the Champion of Champions and Party sections. All bars must be numbered.
- 5. Competitors must report to the Contest Co-ordinator at least 20 minutes before commencement of their class.
- 6. For Own Choice music, time limits will be adhered to:

All Solos 4 minutes Duets & Ensembles 6 minutes

- 7. Juvenile and Junior age limits will be calculated at 2 June 1996, the date of the Championships.
- 8. Winners in Championship Classes must compete in the Junior Champion of Champions or forfeit the win in their class.
- 9. Music for Champion of Champions will be Own Choice. Competitors may use a Test Solo if they wish.
- 10. Ensemble Section is for a group of 5 12 players.
- 11. The Champion Percussionist will be determined by a points system 1st: 5 points, 2nd: 3 points, 3rd: 2 points.
 - In the event of a tie the winner will be decided on a countback based on the highest points gained in Snare Drum, Keyboard Percussion and Timpani respectively.
- Starting times for morning and afternoon sessions only will be provided. Competitors must ensure that they are available to perform when, and as, required.
