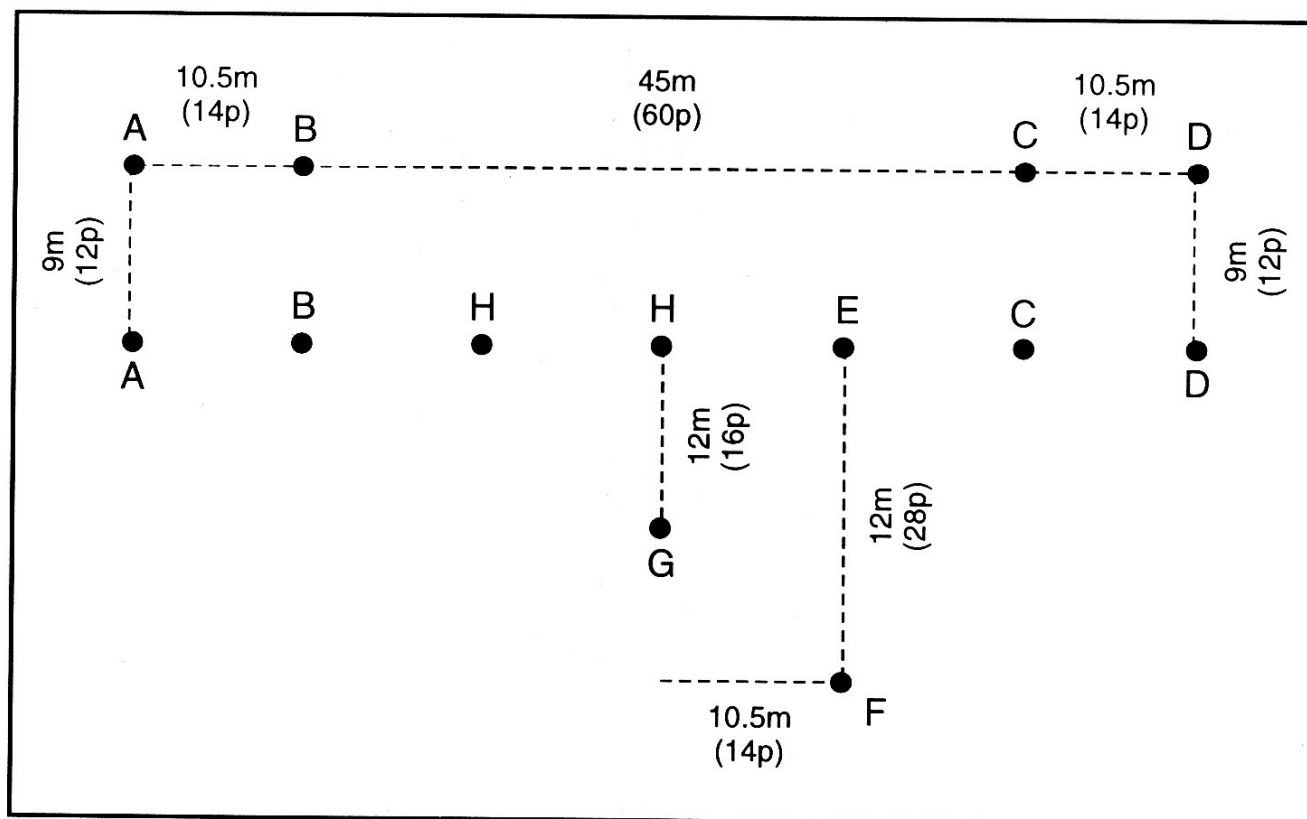

DISTANCES

AA - BB = 14 paces (10.5m)
 BB - CC = 60 paces (45.0m)
 CC - DD = 14 paces (10.5m)

CC - E = 14 paces (10.5m)
 E - F = 28 paces (21.0m)
 F - G = 14 paces (10.5m)
 G - HH = 16 paces (12.0m)

Band will fall in at A.A. in marching formation. Move off in quick time playing their march tune, and March (through CC) to D.D. and perform a GATE COUNTER MARCH (taking care that no members pass beyond DD). Reforming in line with C.C. and march to E, LEFT TURN at E and march to F, RIGHT TURN and march to G, and RIGHT WHEEL.

On completion of the WHEEL, band will commence their OWN CHOICE MARCHING DISPLAY without halting.

Band means Front Rank.

For bands who DO NOT wish to perform an Own Choice Display, the Band must Continue from G.G. and HALT at H.H.

Bands must advise the T.B.L. at the time of Entry registering which option they will do.

i.e: 1. Continue into an Own Choice Display, or 2. Halt at H.H.

Please note all measurements are in metres and paces and use this information in relation to the Diagram.

NOTE: One (1) Pace = .750m

Sixty(60) paces = 45.00m
