CONDITIONS OF CONTEST

1. All rules of the National Band Council and Tasmanian Bands League will be strictly enforced.
2. Bandspersons must appear in band uniform.
3. Competitors will be permitted to use their own accompanist in the duet section provided that the chosen accompanist is available when the competitor is due to perform. Otherwise, the competitor must use the official accompanist.
4. All Own Choice music must be handed to the appropriate official at least 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the section. **All bars must be numbered.**
5. Competitors must report to the Contest Co-ordinator at least 20 minutes before commencement of their class.
6. For Own Choice music, time limits will be adhered to:

Duets	6 minutes
Quartets & Ensembles	8 minutes
7. Junior age limits will be calculated at 6 July 1997, the date of the Championships.
8. All players in a Quartet or Ensemble must be members of the same band.
9. A Quartet or Ensemble may be conducted by a member of the band concerned.
10. Starting times for morning and afternoon sessions only will be provided. Competitors must ensure that they are available to perform when, and as, required.
