CONDITIONS OF CONTEST

1. All rules of the National Band Council and Tasmanian Bands League will be strictly enforced.
2. Bandspersons must appear in band uniform.
3. The Official Entry Form must state whether or not competitors require the official accompanist. If this is not done it will be assumed that the competitors will supply their own accompanist.
4. Competitors will be permitted to use their own accompanist in any section provided that the chosen accompanist is available when the competitor is due to perform. Otherwise, the competitors must use an official accompanist.
5. All Own Choice music must be handed to the appropriate official at least 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the section. All bars must be numbered.
6. Competitors must report to the Contest Co-ordinator at least 20 minutes before commencement of their Class.
7. For Own Choice music, time limits will be adhered to:

All solos (except Champion of Champions)	5 minutes
Duets	6 minutes
Champion of Champions	8 minutes
8.
 - (a) Winners in Championship Classes 1 to 10 must compete in the Junior Champion of Champions or forfeit the win in their Class.
 - (b) Winners in Championship Classes 11 to 20 must compete in the Open Champion of Champions or forfeit the win in their Class.
9. Music for Champion of Champions will be Own Choice. Competitors may use a Test Solo if they wish.
10. Percussionists may compete in any or all of Classes 34-36 (Junior) or 37-39 (Open). The Champion Percussionist in each division will be determined by a points system - 1st, 5 points; 2nd, 3 points; 3rd, 2 points.

In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided on a countback based on the highest points gained in Snare Drum, Mallet Keyboard and Timpani respectively.
11. Starting times for morning and afternoon sessions only will be provided. Competitors must ensure that they are available to perform when, and as, required.

**PROFILE ON
MR MARK FORD B.Ed (Mus).**

Mark Ford was born in Melbourne in 1962. His first inspiration came from his father, who is himself a great music lover and euphonium player. Mark began his banding career at the age of seven (7) with the Brunswick City Municipal Band (Melb) under the direction of his uncle, Ray Hines. He is currently the Principal Conductor with the Kew Band, winner of the 1998 National 'A' Grade Championship. Mark is also Musical Director of the Brunswick Brass Band, the current National 'B' Grade Champion, and is Lecturer-in-Charge of Brass Bands at the Victorian College of the Arts.

As a performer, Mark Ford has become a noted soloist in brass circles, winning many major competitions and Eisteddfods. Notable amongst his achievements were the Victorian Junior Champion of Champions in 1975, Australian Open Soprano Champion 1980 and Victorian Open Champion of Champions 1984.

Mark is also a respected brass educator and sought after adjudicator. He has judged many major events including the Victorian Brass Band Championships, Royal South Street, Ballarat 1992/93 and Victorian State Solo & Party Championships 1993 and 1994. In 1994 he officiated in Tasmania on two occasions; as Chief Adjudicator at the Devonport Eisteddfod and Tasmanian State Brass Band Championships. In October 1997 he officiated at Queensland's Nambour Contest. Mark's latest appointment was that of Associate Adjudicator at the 1998 'Vic Health' Australian National Band Championships held in Melbourne over Easter. He is currently a member of the Victorian Bands' League's *'Music Advisory Board'*.

Mark has been active in the training of young instrumental musicians throughout Victoria, having been teaching music in schools for ten (10) years, and has conducted many music camps, tours and workshops. He was a foundation member of the Victorian State Youth Brass Band in 1979 and fulfilled the role as Assistant Conductor to Doug Trotman O.A.M. from 1987-1992.

Festival of School Bands

Format

Bands will be presented in categories - Junior Concert Band (to Grade 8);

Senior Concert Band (to Grade 12) and Stage Band

The Festivals will be held on Sunday 12th July 1998 in Hobart and Sunday 19th July in Burnie, but the number of entries will determine if some categories of bands need to be held on Saturday the 11th July and Saturday 18th July respectively.

Each band will present a concert programme of no more than 15 minutes

Bands will be audio-taped with voice-over comments from the listener for the Festivals, Mr David Roffe, Sydney

Copies of the musical scores used with bars numbered are to be provided to the organising committee before the commencement of the Festival

The musical assessment will include a rating based on a National standard

Bands will receive their audio-tape together with a plaque commemorating their participation in the Festival

Whilst the Festival is not a competition, there will be a special trophy and award for the band deemed by Mr Roffe to have shown the greatest potential in the presentation of their programme

Large percussion instruments, music stands and podium will be provided to ease transport arrangements

Band directors will greatly assist the organisers by providing a stage layout for their group.

Brief background notes on each band (Provided by the school) will be included in the printed programme

The entry fee is \$20 per school plus \$10 for each additional band

Entries close Wednesday 17th June

All participants will be admitted free of charge to the venue to listen to other bands

Admission charges for members of the general public are \$4 adults, \$2 concession and \$10 for a family group

A food outlet for purchase of sandwiches, pies, soft drinks etc will be on-site

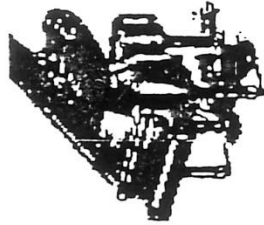

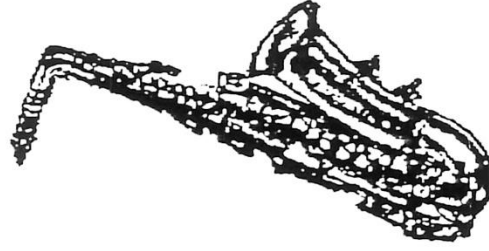
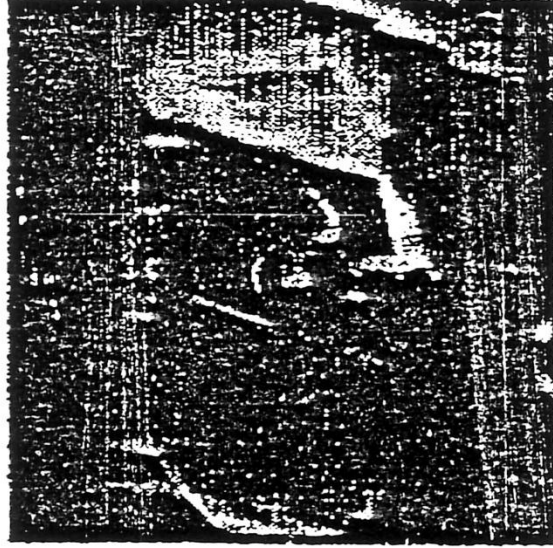
