CONDITIONS OF CONTEST

1. All rules of the National Band Council of Australia and Tasmanian Bands League will be strictly enforced.
2. Bandspersons must appear in band uniform.
3. All Own Choice music must be handed to the appropriate official at least 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the section. **All bars must be numbered.**
4. Competitors must report to the Contest Co-ordinator at least 20 minutes before commencement of their class.
5. For Own Choice music, time limits will be adhered to:

Quartets & Ensembles	8 minutes
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6. Junior age limits will be calculated at 27 June 1999, the date of the Championships.
7. All players in a Quartet or Ensemble must be members of the same band.
8. A Quartet or Ensemble may be conducted by a member of the band concerned.
9. Starting time for morning session only will be provided. Competitors must ensure that they are available to perform when, and as, required.
