Mr McGowan has been involved in bands since a boy when he learned to play the cornet at age 11. Though largely self-taught, he took invaluable lessons from David King, Tom Paulin and Geoff Payne. Since then, he has played around the world (including America, England, Jamaica, The Philippines, Japan, Ecuador and New Zealand). He has played with many bands including Kew, Hawthorn, Yorkshire Building Society ('YBS'), playing every style of music including brass and concert band, gospel, jazz, orchestral, big band, mariachi and rock, on cornet, trumpet, flugel and slide trumpet. He has recorded radio jingles and more than twelve albums of music. He has competed as a soloist (concerto winner and twice champion of champions) and principal cornet (twice Australian national A grade champion and multiple State champion). He has played under many great conductors including David King, Tom Paulin, Doug Trottmann, Ian Viney, Mark Ford, Leif Sundstrup, Ken McDonald, Graham Lloyd and Warren Judd. He retired from playing in 2001 and since then has adjudicated both solo and band contests. He has received the VBL Award of Merit and Long Service Medal. In his spare time, Mr McGowan is a barrister in Melbourne with a family which includes two young children.
